State Board Accepts Settlement Agreement

At its meeting on June 8, 2010 the Ohio State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors accepted a settlement agreement from **Mark Steiner, P.E.** Steiner, a resident of Xenia, Ohio, failed to respond to two separate requests to submit his continuing education documentation during the Board's annual audit. Ohio law requires that professional engineers and professional surveyors must respond within 30 days to the Board's request for information. Steiner agreed that although he completed the continuing professional development requirement his failure to respond to the Board for over 15 months constituted a violation of R.C. 4733. Steiner entered into a settlement agreement wherein he agreed to pay a \$500.00 fine and receive a written reprimand.
